**LeMieux/US Dressage Finals
Regions Cup Perpetual Trophy**
Highest Scoring LeMieux/US Dressage Finals Regional Team

- One Regional Team per USDF Region
- Regional teams will be named after the US Dressage Finals closing date
 - Each regional team consists of:

1. *Top scoring eligible athlete/horse combination from:*

- Reserve athlete/horse combinations will be substituted only once the athlete/horse combination they would be replacing has withdrawn from the finals class(es).
- In the case of competitors having the same score in one of the four categories (Training-First, Second-Fourth, Training-Fourth, FEI), the competitor with the score from the highest level (i.e., Grand Prix vs. Prix St. Georges) will be given the first option of accepting.
- If competitors have the same score at the same level, the placing at the regional championship will be used to determine who will be given first option of accepting.
- If both levels and placings are the same, a coin toss will decide which rider would have the first option of accepting.

2. *Winning team is determined by:*

- Averaging the highest final scores achieved by each athlete/horse combination in their non-freestyle US Dressage Finals class at the required level.
- When an eligible athlete/horse competes in two Finals championships (i.e., Second and Third) in the category that they represent, the higher score will be used in calculating their team results.
- If a Regional Team has the scores from three athlete/horse combinations but does not have a fourth score due to the fourth athlete/horse combination not being able to compete, then the average of the three scores earned will be used as the fourth score in calculating the final team score. Athlete/horse combinations who compete but are eliminated will receive a 0 (zero) as a score for the class from which they were eliminated.

- Prizes will be mailed to the top three teams after the competition.
